iPad Initial Set Up

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Set Up:

- Peripherals of the iPad
- Connect to Wi-Fi
- Set up Apple ID (use personal email account)
 - All apps will stay on YOUR Apple ID they are property of you.
 - If you purchase apps, you can put them on a different iPad should you choose to purchase your own iPad as long as you use your same Apple ID
 - Don't discount paid apps there are some really amazing ones out there
- Set up email, download favorite apps, make folders
- General Settings & uses, swipe, pull up from bottom, etc.

Notes:

- Always update your iPad software when needed.
- Any red circles on the Apps mean that they need attention when you see it on the App Store you should update the apps that need to be updated.
- To delete apps you don't like just press and hold the app. When it starts to wiggle you can press the black "x" in the corner and it will delete off the iPad. To make the apps stop "wiggling" press the home button.
